And, our long-standing Thursday evening session is scheduled for 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. on the first Thursday of the month. Talk to a Lawyer is one of the ways that the local bar interacts in a positive way with members of the public. This service also helps relieve some of the caller demand at our partner programs like Indiana Legal Services, the Legal Aid Society, and the EBA's Lawyer Referral Service. Volunteering is easy, fun, and there are snacks. Please consider signing up for as many dates as you can and if your firm would like to staff one of the sessions please let us know. Thank you!

LIBRARIAN'S CORNER: NEW COPIER AND NEW PRICING

At the end of October, the law library received a new *Canon* copier to **test**. Law firms and their attorneys are now able to enter their user code to make color or black/white copies at the machine or print color or black/white documents from the public access computers. Because of the EBA's and Law Library Foundation's strong commitment to providing access to justice for all members of our community, the law library has been able to LOWER the cost of copying and printing.

Black/white documents cost \$.15 per page; color costs \$.25 per page. Law Library Foundation members continue to receive a discount as a benefit of their membership (\$.10 per page). Your ongoing support of the law library makes it possible for self-represented litigants involved in any matter to access self-help materials located in the law library at this new lower cost. 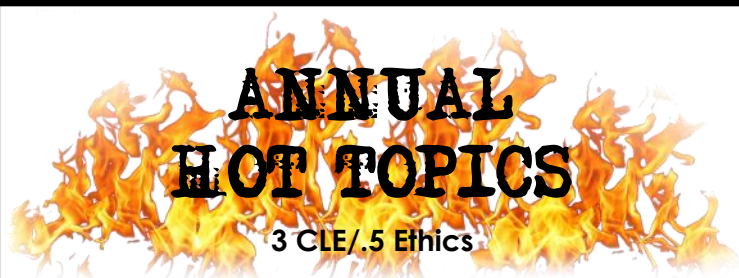
